Yang Family Tai Chi ' s Teacher Training Method-1 (TTM-1) Program is designed to provide interested tai chi chuan practitioners to train to become entry-level teachers of Yang Family Tai Chi Chuan. TTM-1 was created by the International Yang Family Tai Chi Chuan Association to standardize the teaching of Yang Family Tai Chi Chuan by instructors.

Teacher Training Method (TTM) - Yang Family Tai Chi

Academy training is conducted worldwide at National Training Headquarters, Yang Family Tai Chi Centers, Yang Family Tai Chi Schools, and at other locations approved by the Teacher Academy Head. National Training Headquarters are Yang Family Tai Chi Centers designated by the Association to organize, plan, schedule and manage the Teacher Academy program in the country where the Center is located.

Tai Chi Teacher Academy - Yang Family Tai Chi

Grandmaster Yang Zhenduo was born in Beijing in 1926 and his ancestral home is Yanmenzhai, Yongnian County, Hebei. Since childhood, he inherited the family tradition under the guidance of his father and brothers from his young age. After the death of his father, he returned to Yongnian with his mother and worked hard for decades. His tai chi chuan style was chic and graceful, with vigorous strength and steadiness.

Home - Yang Family Tai Chi

Yang Shou-chung (aka Yeung Sau Chung, Yang Zhen-Ming, 1910 – 1985) is from the fourth generation of the Yang family. He was the oldest son of Yang Chengfu by his first marriage, and started learning his family-style when he was eight years old under the strict supervision of his father. In 1949, he escaped from the Chinese communists to Hong Kong. There he taught many students privately at his home until his death in 1985.
