The Piano Sonata No. 12 in F major, K. 332 (300k) by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was published in 1784 along with the Piano Sonata No. 10 in C major, K. 330, and Piano Sonata No. 11, K. 331. Mozart wrote these sonatas either while visiting Munich in 1781, or during his first two years in Vienna. Some believe, however that Mozart wrote this and the other sonatas during a summer 1783 visit to Salzburg made for the purpose of introducing his wife, Constanze to his father, Leopold. POINTS OF INTEREST — MOZART, SONATA IN F, K. 332, I, EXPOSITION! There are seven distinct thematic ideas here, if the transition is included; by way of comparison, the exposition to Beethoven ' s op. 2 no. 1 (the only other sonata-form movement studied thus far) has

only three distinct themes (or possibly four, if one breaks the ST into two parts).

It also contains editor's fingerings, some articulation signs, added only by a comparison with authentic Mozart's indications in similar passages or phrases, and suggested dynamic marks, which are provided in small print. Piano Method

The results and implications of Tyson's work on Mozart have had a profound impact on virtually every aspect of research on this composer.
